CPR Pro for the Professional

CPR Pro for the Professional Rescuer is intended for participants who must have credential ( a card ) documenting successful completion of a course in CPR and BLS for healthcare professionals. Such credentials are typically required for people who provide healthcare to patients in a wide variety of settings, both in-hospital and outside the hospital. This course will teach you how to recognize and respond to life-threatening emergencies such as cardiac arrest respiratory arrest and foreign body airway obstruction ( choking ). You will learn to recognize heart attack and stroke in adults and breathing difficulty in children.

6-8 hours ( 2 year certification )

CPR for the Community & Workplace (ASHI)

If you want to know what to do in an emergency, CPR for the Community & Workplace course can help you. With the knowledge and skills you learn in this course, you can save the life of a loved one, a friend, a co-worker, or a citizen in your community.

This course will teach you how to recognize & treat life-threatening emergencies, including cardiac arrest and choking. You will also learn to recognize the warning signs of a heart attack and stroke in adults and signs of breathing difficulty in children.

4 hours ( 2 year certification )

This is a recertification course for those who have cards that are expiring and need to recertify.

Basic First Aid

First Aid is the immediate care given to due injured or suddenly ill person. It is a temporary assistance that is rendered until competent medical care, if needed, arrives and takes over.

This is a basic course that will concentrate on the first five minutes of care.

Properly applied first aid can save lives, reduce recovery time, and quite possibly be the difference between temporary disability or lifelong disability for a victim.
