20 **b. Fundraisers for 2009:**

22 Discussion continued on fund raiser events which included some car washes. The
23 group decided they would do a car wash on March 28th at McDonald's on Howland Boulevard
24 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Mrs. Brown advised that she would check with McDonald's to
25 find out what was required. They agreed to wash only and not to dry any vehicles. They
26 wanted to do as many car washes as possible up to the time of the dance as the money was
27 needed to host the dance.

29 Shannon Foster agreed to make the tickets to sell for the car wash and to email them to
30 Mrs. Brown for approval by March 11th. The group agreed to meet back at City Hall on
31 Tuesday, March 17, 2009 at 5:30 p.m. to make the car wash posters on foam boards.

33 They also discussed speaking with Beef O'Brady's about doing a fundraiser at the
34 restaurant.

36 They voted on a theme for the dance by using the number method to vote. The theme
37 choices were Pajama Jam and Grease. The results of the voting were:

42 A date of June 6, 2009 was chosen from 6:00-10:00 p.m. at Wes Crile Park. They
43 would show up an hour early to decorate and get the gym ready. They discussed music,
44 supervision, help from the Sheriff's department, food, etc. They decided to charge \$2.00 for
45 admission and to sell pizza and soda. Discussion to continue at subsequent meetings.

16 Complex. The members will choose the location when they go to the park for the
17 Eggstravaganza event on April 4, 2009.

21 Mr. Moore said he was excited at all the positive discussions and told them to keep up
22 the good work.

26 The Vice Chair said she wanted to set up communication so that they all stayed in
27 touch at least once a week by email and/or by phone.

29 Miss Foster said she was happy that they were busy.

31 Miss Bianca Walker wanted to make sure that the kids would be appropriately dressed
32 for the dance in June.
