

NORMANDY BOULEVARD WIDENING

Construction is set to begin on the widening of Normandy Boulevard to 4 lanes with a grassed median, concrete curbs and 4' wide sidewalks. The lane improvements will run from Saxon Boulevard to just north of Firwood Drive. Construction is set to begin in the next 30 to 60 days and will be broken into phases.

- Phase 1 will be from north of Firwood Drive to south of Elkcam Boulevard
- Phase 2 will be from Elkcam Boulevard to south of Vercelli Street
- Phase 3 will be from Vercelli Street to Saxon Boulevard
- Phase 4 will be the work on Elkcam Boulevard

The contractor will be required to limit the bulk of the construction work to the hours between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday.

There will also be work done on 4 existing retention ponds to improve capacity.

- Pond 1 is located on the east side of Normandy Boulevard, just north of Apache Circle
- Pond 2 is located between Elwood Street and Gainsboro Street, just east of Anchor Drive
- Pond 3 is located just east of Gallagher Avenue, across from Geraldine Drive
- Pond 4 is located between Normandy Boulevard and El Campo Avenue, south of Applegate Terrace
