What is the Community Emergency Response Team?

The City of Deltona CERT program is an educational program for local citizens and business owners/operators that is intended to prepare you to help yourself, your family and your neighbors in the event of a catastrophic disaster.

What does the Course Involve?

The CERT training course consists of 21 hours of training and 3 hours of practical exercise. The course is held every Saturday for 4 weeks and each session requires hands-on, interactive training. There are no examinations required to pass this program, however, your skills will be measured through practical exercise.

Throughout the course, you will learn information which will assist your family and community during the first critical hours after a disaster. At the conclusion of the program, students will receive a certificate from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and a volunteer CERT identification card.

Course Topics

Session 1 - DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

Introduction to disasters, impact of disasters on infrastructures, the role of CERTs in disaster response.

Session 2 - FIRE SUPPRESSION

Identifying and reducing potential fire hazards, basic fire suppression strategy, resources, and techniques.

Session 3 - DISASTER MEDICAL OPERATIONS, PART 1

Treatment strategies for life-threatening conditions and principals of triage.

Session 4 - DISASTER MEDICAL OPERATIONS, PART 2

Head-to-toe assessments, treatment for various injuries.

Session 5 - LIGHT SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATIONS

Techniques for size-up and search, lifting, cribbing and removing victims, rescuer safety.

Session 6 - PRE-STORM OPERATIONS

Protecting your home from severe weather, personal readiness, CERT equipment, organizing your team.

Session 7 - POST-STORM CERT OPERATIONS

Organizing, deploying teams, communications, and recovery.
