**SPECIAL MEETING**  
**Tuesday, May 26, 2009**

A Special Meeting of the Youth Advisory Sub-Committee was held on Tuesday, May 26, 2009 in the City of Deltona's 1st Floor Kitchen at 2345 Providence Blvd., Deltona, Florida.

**1. CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by the Vice Chair, Jennifer Slone.

**2. ROLL CALL:**

**3. NEW BUSINESS:**

**Teen Dance at Wes Crile on June 6th:**

This special meeting was called in order to finalize everything for the Teen Dance on Saturday, June 6, 2009 at the Wes Crile Gym.

Food items were discussed and the sub-committee decided that the pizzas and cakes should be deleted from the list. The flavors of sodas were decided on, as well as the candy mix and the layout of the room with the tables and chairs.

Mrs. Maria Greene, a parent, agreed to be at the dance to assist with keeping order. Mrs. Brown advised that if there was misconduct from anyone present, they would be asked to leave the event. The Slones' brother would also assist at the door and with helping to keep order.

The Slone sisters brought in some of the leftover decorations from their Sweet Sixteen party to be used at the teen dance. Colors were discussed. Mrs. Brown advised that the Parks and Recreation Department would not be spending money on decorations; lighting would be low so the decorations would not really be on display. The decorating colors were changed from purple and green to silver and black as those colors were already on hand from the decorations brought in by the Slone sisters. The group decided that they would use multi colored balloons

1 to provide color. The balloons would be placed in the center of the tables which would cut  
2 down on purchasing additional balloons.

4 Two prizes were donated by members for 2 winners of the dance contest (for best performance)  
5 and for 2 winners of the Karaoke contest. After discussion the group agreed to have a “Don’t  
6 forget the Lyrics” contest instead of the Karaoke which they felt would be better received.  
7 There would be one door prize.

8  
9 The flyer was discussed and Mrs. Brown explained that she had to have the flyer re-done  
10 because of the disclaimers that needed to be on there. She explained that this was no reflection  
11 on Shannon and the work she did with the original flyer, as the disclaimer information was not  
12 given to her, but because time was against us she needed the flyer to be redone quickly. Mrs.  
13 Brown consulted with another member of staff and it was determined not to call it a “Pajama”  
14 party but rather an end of the year school “Jam” party as some kids would not want to come to  
15 a party in PJs. She explained that for advertising, there would be posters placed in various park  
16 lobbies; that an eblast would be sent to Deltona residents; that it would be on the Parks Web  
17 Page and on the Teen Web Page; that a press release would be done and a slide would be put  
18 on the City’s TV Channel 199 as well as on the marquees displayed at the entryways to the  
19 City.

21 The group wanted the dance contest to be done to the following songs: “Now Drop”, “Freeze”  
22 by T. Payne, “Just Dance” and “Step Up”.

23  
24 The group decided that each person admitted to the dance would be given a glow in the dark  
25 bracelet which would identify them as having paid. The admission price was rounded to \$3.00  
26 for singles and \$5.00 for couples.

27  
28 The Parks and Recreation Department would be providing the tables, chairs, coolers, ice,  
29 drinks, snacks, paper good, glow in the dark bracelets and the D.J.

30  
31 It was decided that the group would meet Mrs. Brown at Wes Crile Park between 4:00-4:30  
32 p.m. on Saturday, June 6<sup>th</sup> to assist with the decorating and set up for the dance. Mrs. Brown  
33 told them there would be no climbing to hang anything as she did not want anyone to get hurt.  
34 The group was reminded that they could have fun but they were also to be observant of their  
35 surroundings to make sure that the gym stayed clean; that they needed to report any spills they  
36 saw on the floor so that injuries could be avoided as well as to report any other noticeable  
37 problems. She asked the members to stay back at 10:00 p.m. to help her with the clean-up and  
38 the removal of all the decorations. All the committee members agreed to help.

40 The group discussed taking instant pictures and charging the attendees a small fee as a way to  
41 make back some of the monies being spent on this event. Alexis and Bianca Walker provided  
42 the photo frames for the picture. They advised, however, that the cost of the ink would run  
43 about \$50.00 for 100 photos. The group decided that they would rather not incur any other  
44 expense at this time so the photo idea was scrapped for this event.
