

Construction Update for Fort Smith Blvd Roadway Improvements (Between Primrose Terrace and Rookery Drive)

During the second week of August, the section of Fort Smith Blvd between India Blvd and Preston Avenue that has been closed for construction will be re-opened to through traffic. The detour that is currently in place (moving Fort Smith Blvd traffic to Leeward Drive from India Blvd to Preston Avenue) will be removed.

India Blvd will be closed to through traffic between Fort Smith Blvd and Leeward Drive when the previous detour is removed. India Blvd traffic will be detoured on Fort Smith Blvd to Lightfoot Street, Leeward Drive, and back to India Blvd. Only residents living on India Blvd between Fort Smith Blvd and Leeward Drive will be allowed access to this section of India Blvd during construction. Storm drainage system, curb, paving and sidewalk will be constructed on the south 700 feet of India Blvd connecting to Fort Smith Blvd. It is anticipated that the work on India Blvd will be completed, and detour removed by November.

Storm drainage and roadway construction work will also be taking place during this period on Fort Smith Blvd from Primrose Terrace to India Blvd, and from Pemberton Avenue to Courtland Blvd.
