WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 3, 2009**

A Special Meeting of the Deltona City Commission was held on Monday, August 3, 2009 at the City Hall Commission Chambers, 2345 Providence Boulevard, Deltona, Florida.

**1. CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Mulder.

**3. BUSINESS:**

**A. Discussion and further action regarding the Separation Agreement with the City Attorney, George Trovato, and take any action necessary.**

Commissioner McFall-Conte stated the latest draft shows the resignation would be effective September 1, 2009, in Section 2(a) the payout amount was changed to \$108,290.00 and in Section 2(b) the City will pay for COBRA as of September 1, 2009. Mr. Cino stated Mr. Trovato will receive the City's health benefits through the month of August, September 1<sup>st</sup> will be the qualifying date and Mr. Trovato will be on COBRA for 18 months. He stated the City would pay part of the COBRA and the government would pay part of the COBRA which would give the City a credit for a portion of it.

Commissioner McFall-Conte stated Mr. Trovato agreed to the 10 ½ months' severance and he asked that for tax purposes the amount not be a lump sum and to be paid \$3,200 a month until the \$108,290 runs out. She stated in Section 6 the labor attorney asked to define the City as the City Manager, the City Attorney and the City Commission. She stated in Section 6 was changed so that media inquiries would go through the City Manager.

Mr. Cino stated there was a positive letter of reference which he drafted and provided to Mayor Mulder.
